Today we met with your two nominated representatives; Michael O'Neill and Richard Bendell. In summary we spoke about the current situation, investigations being undertaken, and potential timeframes for getting further information to you.

### Investigation update

Council, via external solicitors, have engaged geotechnical engineers to investigate the site and the source of the landslide. Multiple investigations are ongoing and these include:

- Survey and Photogrammetry Modelling
- Aerial imaging
- Water testing
- Preliminary Engineering Geological Mapping
- Investigation of assets
- Landslide characterisation

### Insurance concerns

Several people have raised concerns about insurance policies that have a clause relating to a premises being vacant for over 60 days. If you have concerns about this, please contact me.
