Comms to go out to impacted residents: "The Roads and Drainage Team appreciates residents' patience and understanding regarding the time taken to investigate this issue. Since the only water asset managed by Council is stormwater, which was ruled out early in the investigation, it was necessary to allow South East Water sufficient time to determine whether any of their assets or associated works were contributing to the problem. Now that the investigations into the water source have concluded without a definitive result, we have scheduled works to commence this Wednesday. These works aim to manage the groundwater issue and repair the affected road surfaces. The project will involve major excavation, drainage installation, and asphalt repairs. Residents may experience some temporary impacts during this time, and we appreciate your cooperation as we work to resolve the issue."	TBA
