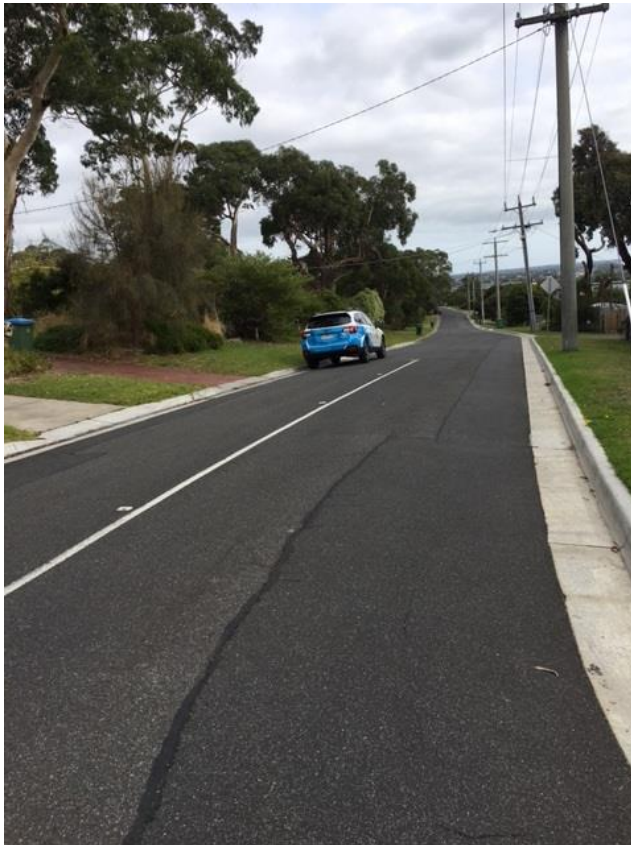

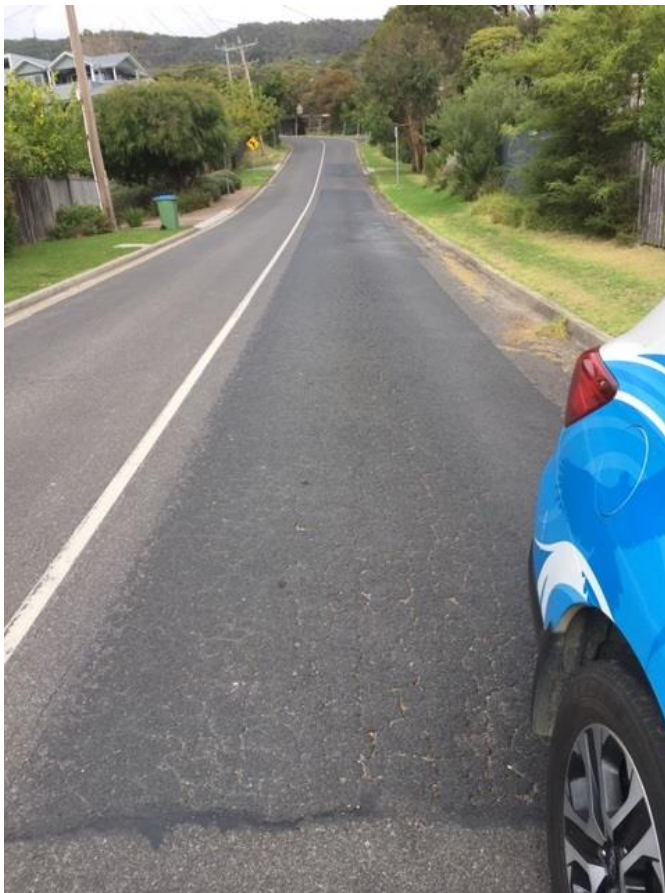






Photo 11 **Generally looking at Coburn Avenue I believe the road surface is in relatively good condition except for the few areas identified in the attached photos.**

Looking at Coburn from Point Nepean Road uphill towards Burrell Street there is a large patch of While there is some surface cracking and some minor undulation in several areas, if residents consider this road is an example of poor condition, they must have very good roads around this area, or they expect very high standards. cracking and signs of subsurface material starting to pump through the pavement surface. This area needs attention. **See Courtney from DM Roads comments on maintenance at that location below.**

Hi Tom,

The last inspection of Coburn Avenue was done around end of February of 2023.

The inspection team picked up multiple pothole defects which have all since been repaired.

TASK ID: 5314.0595 2x potholes 30m in from Pt Nep Rd (Completed 25.02.23)

No further works since then 😊
