605 POINT NEPEAN RD	FRONT LEFT BOUNDARY AT FENCE
607-609 POINT NEPEAN RD	FRONT CENTRE OF BOUNDARY AT GARDEN TAP
2 PENNY LANE	FRONT OF PROPERTY AT WALL LEFT OF DOUBLE GATE/DRIVEWAY
4/613 POINT NEPEAN RD	FRONT RIGHT CORNER OF UNIT AT THE WALL
2/613 POINT NEPEAN RD	FRONT OF PROPERTY AT FENCE NEAR GAS METER
6 VIEW POINT RD	FRONT LEFT CORNER OF PROPERTY AT GARDEN TAP

We are excluding 3 Penny lane because of damage and 10 View Point Rd because it has a 25mm meter, and at this time we only replacing 20mm meters.
