## Bushfire Planning discussion paper - 10/30 rule

Our Environmental Planning and Emergency Recovery team advise that at this point in time there is no intention to review the bushfire exemptions.

### Implementation of changes to the PE Act

Our Legislative Reform team advise the intention is to provide information and guidance closer to the commencement of the changes.

They said the default commencement date for Consumer and Planning Legislation Amendment Act is 25 November 2025, however, they anticipate some of the planning changes may commence prior to that date. DTP will provide confirmation of the proposed commencement dates in due course. In addition, further advice and information will be provided to councils in the months before commencement to support them in implementing the reforms.

Keep an eye on Planning Matters in the first instance, which the team will use to circulate early information.

# **Timing of codification of Clause 54**

The latest advice is that it will be in the next few months, but I have nothing more specific than that.
