Inspection:

- Paraphrase from Gerry; decision to be made when rectifying the slip area, do we go with the natural soil profile or what is safe?
- David states as close to the natural soil profile but ultimately as safe as possible – up to the geotechs
- Gerry states that 6 view point road wont pass a risk to life assessment
- Wetland reeds as noted by Civil contractor are growing on the escarpment perpendicular to the slide site in a straight line – See images below



- If council does not co-operate with Gerry and Bronwyn. Gerry has threatened to pull the fencing down and move back into his house.
- After the meeting with the contractors Gerry and Bronwyn are handed with the notices of entry
- They are a bit taken a back and don't believe that the basement is relevant to the landslip and council aren't using resources effectively and will be taking council to court
- Gerry has a brief read of the documents and has asked for them to be sent electronically for his lawyer to review them, but says he most likely will sign them
- Afterwards Dane digs holes on the two realm drains that are connected to old septic tank
- Under neath both realm drains was dry however root systems where visible potentially indicating water has been using the realm drains
