- Dave brings forward proposal to the owner of the property and owners son; Either wait approx. 3 months for council geotechs to do a ultra conservative life risk assessment (paid for by council) or they have the option to consult their own Geotech (who is to be approved by Dave) in conjunction with 18-20 Viewpoint.
