Water Leak Charlesworth St, McCrae

With regards the landslide at McCrae there was a significant water leak in Charlesworth Street which I took photos of

The water was flowing out of the road for about 3 weeks prior to me taking the photos, so approximately it started in November. Water was also heard gushing down the storm water drain in Waller Place nearby.

This water leak was still flowing on the 13th of January on which I reported it to South East Water and the Mornington Peninsula Shire Council. On the 14th of January the council rang me to report that they would repair the water leak the next day, the afternoon after the landslide.

The road was dug up and 3 metres down a water pipe existed but the water was flowing on the outside of the pipe. I believe there was a significant leak of a water main in or near Outlook rd the otherside of the freeway.
